- a) **Presentation by Denison High School Monarch Academy-** Achol Anyar and Celeste Gomez, freshmen students at Denison High School shared their FBLA state conference experiences, which took place in March, with the board. Dave Wiebers, HS Principal, shared with the board some recent experiences that some Monarch Academy students have had in regards to helping redecorate the offices at the Iowa High School Athletic Association in Boone.
