

Denison Community School Registration Information

- Denison CSD is requiring an online registration process through PowerSchool, the District's student information system. **You may register your child and/or children from home starting August 1st.** Please log on to www.denison.k12.ia.us and click on the link in the lower left corner "Powerschool Parent Portal Link". Log on to PowerSchool and complete the E-Registration button for each of your children. You may mail a check should you choose instead of paying online. The check would be mailed to Denison Community Schools, 819 North 16th Street, Denison, Iowa 51442. **Please indicate in a note your child and/or children's name(s) along with what the check is for (ex. John Smith 7th grade registration fees and \$40 in lunch account).**
- Anyone filing a Free/Reduced Lunch application will need to complete the enclosed form and bring it to school during the registration times below. Only one application per family is needed. **To qualify for free/reduced registration fees, you must complete the waiver form in addition to the lunch application.**

Needed Information to Enroll a Child at Denison Community Schools

Proof of Age:

Children in the school district community will be allowed to enroll in the school district's regular education program beginning at age five. A student shall not be admitted to kindergarten unless the student is five years old on or before September 15 of the current year. A student shall not be admitted to first grade unless the student is six years old on or before September 15 of the current year. The board shall require evidence of age and residency in the form of a birth certificate or other evidence before the student may enroll in the school district's education program.

Immunizations:

Students new to Denison Community Schools have ninety days to complete the state required immunizations. A student is not allowed to enroll in school without the required immunizations or a signed provisional certificate stating that immunizations have been started or records from another school are being requested.

Please contact Crawford County Public Health at 712-263-3303 or one of the school buildings offices to assist you in obtaining the proper immunizations. Public Health in Denison holds regular immunizations clinics three times per month. The clinics are held on the 1st Monday, 1st Tuesday, and 3rd Thursday of each month. You may also contact a local doctor's office.

Medications/Inhalers taken at school:

If it is necessary for your child to take medicine at school, parental permission is required by sending a written note to the nurse. Students are to bring all medications to the nurse's office immediately upon their arrival at school. They are not to carry medication with them during the school day or keep it in their locker or school bag. All medication must be in the original container, **NO BAGGIES OR ENVELOPES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT SCHOOL.** Our policy is written for the safety and welfare of your child.

Medication will be dispensed to students at school only if the following requirements are met;

* Over the counter medication must be in the original container and requires written parental permission.

* Prescription medication must be in the original container from the pharmacy with the directions clearly stated and written parental permission. Labeled containers from the pharmacy are necessary because all prescription medication given at school must have permission from a physician. Your pharmacist will give you a labeled container for school. Inhalers should also have a prescription label on them.
