

## DENISON COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION

August 21, 2017

The Denison Community School District Board of Education met in regular session, Monday, August 21, 2017. The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Board President Rod Bradley in the District Conference Room. Board members answering roll call in addition to Bradley were Kris Rowedder, Larry Andersen, and Dr. Derek Lambert. Director Joe Lally was absent. Also in attendance Superintendent of Schools Mike Pardun, Business Manager Scott Larson building Principals Dave Wiebers, Patti Ryan and Trevor Urich.

Correspondence was shared with the Board from Des Moines Register All Iowa Sports Awards. Gloria Laroca was honored from Denison Community Schools for the Special Olympics.

Motion by Rowedder/Andersen to approve the consent items. AYES: Rowedder, Andersen, Lambert and Bradley. NAYS: none. The consent items include the agenda, board minutes, bills paid between sessions and bills payable.

Six resignations presented for Board approval: Julie Brown, Nancy Zavala, Rebecca Schmidt, Sarah Swanson and Sarah Fineran, all associates, along with Dana Marten Middle School Track Coach. Moved by Andersen/Lambert to approve the resignations as presented. AYES: Andersen, Lambert, Rowedder, and Bradley. NAYS: none.

Seventeen appointments presented for Board approval: Sheri McNamara High School Special Ed Strategist II Teacher, Ashley Jennings High School Assistant Cross Country Coach, Dana Marten High School Assistant Track Coach, Jacob Brawner Middle School Assistant Football and Middle School/High School Assistant Wrestling, Hellen David Broadway Elementary Cook at \$11.84 per hour, Jamie Koch RN for ECSE at \$18.62 per hour, and Christian Barragan, Paula Campbell, Rita Estevao, MacKenzie Freese, Denisse Garcia, Jailene Gutierrez, Tayten Kline, Samantha Schaben, Amanda Stater and Madison Wight all associates at \$11.68 per hour. Moved by Lambert/Andersen to approve the appointments as presented. AYES: Lambert, Andersen, Rowedder and Bradley. NAYS: none.

Motion by Rowedder/Lambert to approve the second reading of Board Policy 308 Succession of Authority. AYES: Rowedder, Lambert, Andersen and Bradley. NAYS: none.

The Board approved the 2017-2018 Food Nutrition Program. Moved by Andersen/Rowedder to approve 2017-2018 Food Nutrition Program. AYES: Andersen, Rowedder, Lambert and Bradley. NAYS: none.

Motion by Rowedder/Lambert to appoint Tina Holdsworth and Chris Eller as Level I Investigators and the Denison Police Department as Level II Investigators for 2017-2018. AYES: Rowedder, Lambert, Andersen and Bradley. NAYS: none.

A brief update was given by Mr. Larson on summer projects. He highlighted the completion of the elementary playground and curbing, high school gym doors replacement, tennis court parking lot completion. Mr. Wiebers shared the completion of the additional parking will mean

that no high school students will be parking at the aquatic center this year. Mr. Larson continued with the summary of completed projects to include the band and vocal A/C, replacement of the high school office windows with the exception of the small movable sections, and the administration office windows will be replaced in the next few weeks.

Broadway Principal, Trevor Urich, reported enrollment is up and open house will be this Tuesday from 12:00 to 5:00PM. The change in hours will be an attempt to give parents a better opportunity to speak with their child's teacher before school starts. Middle School Principal, Patti Ryan, reported that she has all her staff hired, and her building also appears to be up in enrollment. High School Principal, Dave Wiebers, reported enrollment seems to be up in his building as well. 9<sup>th</sup> Grade orientation will be tonight. Mr. Wiebers plans to spend time with the parents explaining the schedules and graduation requirements.
