Update on Denison CSD Learning Plan 2020-2021-Superintendent Pardun gave a brief update on the Denison CSD Learning Plan and then asked each building principal to update the Board. Dave Wiebers, High School Principal, reported the return to full onsite learning for the last two school days and noted staff and students are happy to be back. The High School modified a few classrooms for spacing prior to a return to onsite learning. Patti Ryan, Middle School Principa, reported the move to virtual guests for Ag Days. She mentioned that online learners are able to participate virtually in activities like band to ease the transition back to onsite instruction should they desire. Chris Schulz, Denison Elementary Principal, and Trevor Urich, Broadway Elementary Principal, reported adjustments to lunch schedules to accommodate for social distancing have gone

well along with staff preparations for upcoming parent/teacher conferences. In addition, Principal Schulz shared how second grade students are engaging through virtual learning provided by Mrs. Platt, elementary music instructor, for their upcoming concert which will be presented virtually. Principal Ulrich added how students were completing STAR testing this week.

Discussion on IASB Convention: Superintendent Pardun inquired about which board members would be interested in registering for the annual school board convention, which will be held virtually in November. President Rowedder was interested in the Delegate Assembly on November 17th, 2020. No other members wished to attend.
